A leading **High Street fashion chain** has been fined a record **£400,000** for fire safety breaches after a blaze broke out at a central London branch.

'Potential for tragedy'

The fashion chain was fined £250,000 for failing to supply a "suitable and sufficient" fire risk assessment for the premises and £150,000 for failing to adequately train staff. It was also ordered to pay more than £136,000 costs.

Fire Risk Assessment

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005, effective 1st October 2006, is applicable to ALL UK Businesses, which can be inspected by the Fire Authorities for compliance, non compliance may result in substantial fines and closure of part or all of your workplace and even imprisonment.

The "responsible person/s" must manage any fire risk on the premise, and to do this he/she/they need to carry out a fire risk assessment.

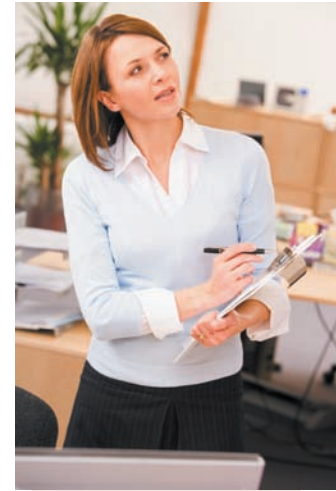

The Fire Risk Assessment will generally follow the principles contained within 'The Fire Safety Risk Assessment Guidance Documents' which recommend a five-step approach:

- Identify Hazards
- Identify persons at risk in the event of a fire
- Evaluate the risks
- Record the significant findings and action taken
- Keep assessment under review

First-Aid Training Solutions

Emergency First Aid Course

This one day course is suitable for workplaces classed as lower-risk, and those with fewer than 100 employees. This CIEH Level 2 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work is accredited by Ofqual, and will enable successful candidates to act as a first aider in the workplace and deal with first aid issues calmly and confidently.



CIEH Level 2 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work (EFAW).

The EFAW training and assessment will cover the following topics:

- Roles and responsibilities of a first aider
- Assessment and management of first aid incidents
- Management of an unconscious casualty
- Management of a casualty who is not breathing normally
- Management of a casualty who is choking
- Management of a casualty who has a bleeding injury
- Management of a casualty who is in shock

Designed for: first aiders in lower-risk work environments

Course duration: one-day programme

Assessment method: practical assessment plus an examination consisting of 15 multiple choice questions

Ofqual accreditation: Ofqual reference: 500/7534/2 Level: 2

Pre-requisite: None

Successfully completing the CIEH Level 2 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work course will qualify candidates to become a first aider in their workplace.

In addition to receiving a certificate, each successful candidate will receive a wallet-sized ID card, stating that they are a qualified first aider.
